It is with unfeigned regret that we announce the death on Friday last, of Mr. E. B. Boulter.

Mr. Boulter was for a considerable time a resident of Rushworth, and by his honorable and consistent conduct gained the respect and esteem of all with whom he came in contact.

It will be remembered that he was one of the candidates for the representation of the Waranga Division of the Sandhurst Mining Board at the last election, and that he withdrew in favor of Mr, A. G. Thom. Had he stood, his many estimable qualities would doubtless have secured him considerable support.

On Sunday last, the day on which he was buried, about 150 persons of all ranks followed his remains to the Rushworth Cemetery, where the last sad rites were performed.

He leaves a widow and child to mourn his loss.

The funeral service was conducted by Mr Short, of the Church of England.
