

Mrs W. Chamberlain

A very old resident of the Rushworth and Heathcote districts in the person of Mrs. W. Chamberlain, passed away on Thursday of last week, at the residence of her niece, Mrs. E. Lawley, Stanhope road, Rushworth, at the age of 84 years.

The late Mrs Chamberlain was born in Wales, England [?], and came to Australia in 1860. She resided in Redcastle, Heathcote and latterly in Rushworth with Mrs. Lawley, up to the time of her death. She had been practically an invalid for some time.

She leaves her husband, but there was no family.

The late Mrs. Chamberlain was of a kind and cheerful disposition and was much respected.

The funeral took place on Saturday last, the remains being interred in the Rushworth Cemetery. The burial service was conducted by Rev. H. F. Goss (Anglican).

The coffin was borne to the grave by the deceased's nephews.
